

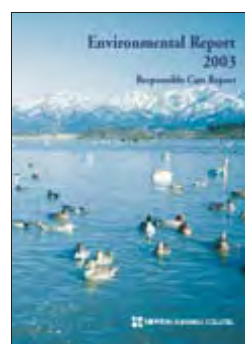
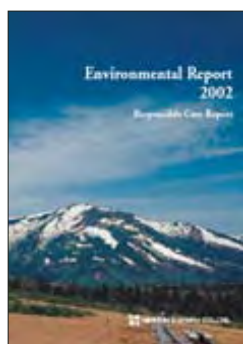
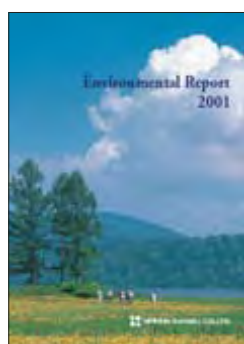
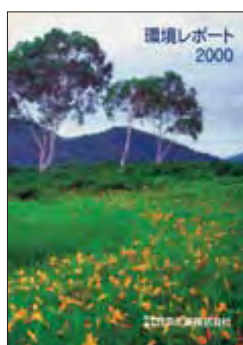
Past Issues of Environmental Reports

Editor's note

- This is the eighth environment report, the first issue of which was published in March 2000. In 2004, we changed its name from the “Environment Report” to the “Environmental & Safety / Sustainability Report,” containing not only information on environmental and safety issues, but also that of social matters. Although this eighth report follows the format of the previous one, its contents are further enhanced.
- Up until now, the volume of this annual report had been increasing every year, however this year's report has 18 pages less volume than the one from last year, with a total of 54 pages. In the “Society” section, we have added a new chapter “Relationship with Customers.”
- The results of the environmental impact point calculation

using JEPIX were a new addition to this report this year. By comparing the results for fiscal 1996, the year we initiated our Responsible Care activities, with those for fiscal 2001 and 2006, a definite reduction in the environmental burdens is indicated in a single index.

- The photographs in this report were taken by the employees of the Nippon Kayaku Group as has been the case in previous issues. The photo on the cover page was selected from 47 photos submitted by 14 employees.
- We intend to use opinions and suggestions we received from the many people who read the Nippon Kayaku Group Environmental & Safety/Sustainability Report 2005 to further improve the contents of the report.
